Narrative Report

I am a pediatric neurologist who specializes in traumatic brain injury. Much of my clinical work takes place around the Pediatric Concussion Program at Boston Medical Center; a multidisciplinary center coordinating care between the Emergency Room, the inpatient and outpatient services but also the common referrals to Physical, Vestibular, Ocular, Speech therapies and Neuropsychology services. My aim is to provide the highest level of care to children and adolescents who have sustained a brain injury by understanding the pathophysiology of the pediatric patient through research and enhancing the health and well-being of patients, minimizing distress, and preventing longer-term difficulties.

In order to achieve this goal, I have developed a Standardized Clinical Assessment and Management Plans, now adopted by the Adult Concussion Clinic at Boston University to continuously review individual patient data for areas in our practice that need improvement, thus ensuring that the Brain Injury program always provides the best, most cost-effective care for our patients. Another goal of the center is access to acute and follow-up care, to which end we began developing an open access clinic in 2013 to provide services at Boston Medical Center, our satellites and across different different specialties.

I am currently the principal and co-principal investigator on 7 studies, and a collaborator in several others. These research projects include a database to understand the challenges patients face in a safety net hospital, specifically in regards to treating both sports and non-sports related concussions and in non-native English speaking populations. I have published several papers in this area, some in close collaboration with other groups here at Boston University like the Chronic Traumatic Encephalopathy (CTE) group. Our research suggests that youth exposure to football may have long-term neurobehavioral consequences. As a result, tackle football in younger children is no longer recommended throughout the country, and sports leagues in the US and Canada have changed their regulations.

My clinical interests have led to my research on traumatic brain injury, ranging from investigating risk factors for prolonged post-concussive symptoms in under-served patients, potential links between head injury in youth and the development of CTE as an adult, the role of psychology in the concussion program, imaging in patients with mild traumatic brain injury with sports and non-sports related problems, telemedicine in the management of concussion, the role of capillary leakage in the pathophysiology of traumatic brain injury (TBI), and databases in our college students as well as young adults to facilitate the transition and long term studies needed for CTE. It has been an important goal to offer the clinical pediatric arm for world known researchers at Boston University, so we can work as a team and increase our overall research capabilities.

Consistent with my origins, I also have interest in Global Health and as such I have been working for the last 20 years in projects in South America in areas of education, research, and support with more than 700,000 US dollars in donations in medical and rehabilitation equipment for ecuadorian children in need through a nonprofit organization I co-founded in Boston in 2004. I also have volunteered for the AAP since 1995 and currently have responsibilities as a Chairman of the Membership and Communications Committee, a member of the Executive Committee of the Section of Global Health of the AAP, and was the senior neurology consultant in a monthly education Teleconference for Latin America in Congenital Zika Syndrome, organized by the group Assist, Echo, USAID and the AAP. I am a periodic reviewer for the Section of Neurology of the AAP and serve as pro-bono consultant for several governments in Central and South America as well as some Caribbean countries.

I have built several programs at Boston Medical Center including the Pediatric Traumatic Brain Injury Program, the Pediatric Neurology Bilingual Program, and International Pediatric Neurology Program, and support the creation of the Adult Concussion Program at Boston Medical Center.

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In summary, through my clinical work, educational activities, leadership and research collaborations, I am improving our understanding of the neurologic outcomes of traumatic brain injury in low income families, so as to offer the best clinical care. These goals also form the foundation of my academic and teaching activities, and serve to unify my career as a clinical child neurologist and clinical researcher.
